Footnotes

SIR TOASTY was not asked for speed in the early going, commenced his bid nearing the second turn, circled rivals four wide into the lane, collared FLYIN ON BYE leaving the furlong pole but was all out to prevail. FLYIN ON BYE was quickly in front to set all of the pace under fine rating, turned back SAUXSOE into the lane then met the winner's bid and gave way grudgingly. ROYAL CLASSIC was permitted to settle early while three wide to the backstretch, advanced outside MAN IN THE MOON to rally into the stretch, shifted out leaving the sixteenth pole and lost some of his punch. SAUXSOE stalked the pace from the rail early, offered his bid two wide into the lane but slackened in the drive. MAN IN THE MOON was well placed early while racing just off the rail, dropped inside on the second turn but did not rally. KEG TAP lagged in the early going while racing just outside SIR TOASTY, tried to rally with that rival into the second turn but could not match strides and had no further response in the stretch. SONNYS BIG BISCUIT (IRE) stalked the pace three wide to the second turn and came up empty. NUMEROUS XS was close up four wide to the backstretch then faded after a half mile.
