ROLLETTE was not asked for speed early, commenced her bid nearing the second turn, circled three wide to the stretch, gained command once straightened for the drive and drew clear but was kept to her task. DEPUTY SONG lagged from the inside to the second turn, rallied into the stretch and finished steadily but could not threaten the winner. PRIZED BUY trailed early just outside DEPUTY SONG, moved in front of that rival to be four wide into the stretch and loomed a factor but lost her punch. SENTIMENTAL SECRET settled early, rallied strongly once on the second turn to gain command two wide into the stretch but had little left for the drive. FIBBER'S STAR set the pace from the rail to midway on the second turn and gave out. FENIX showed little. WINENPLEASURE prompted the pace two wide for five furlongs and stopped.
