QUEENA NINA broke on top then took back off DANIELLA'S BABY and pressed that rival in hand, took command when ready nearing the stretch, drew off and was not asked for her best. DOM BA DOOMBA broke very slow from the inside then rushed up through traffic, angled five wide on the turn and finished steadily. SHESINTHEMEADOW settled early, raced four wide on the turn but lacked a solid closing bid. PINE TAR LADY raced unhurried early, saved ground but failed to offer a bid. DANIELLA'S BABY raced up inside to set the pace to the quarter pole then came up empty. TWOEYESONTHEHELM flashed speed to the turn and faltered. HOPE HE PHONES broke slow and was never a factor. IT'S YOU had no speed. AGREED was finished early. TWIN RIVER stalked the pace to the turn and gave way steadily while three wide. LA PETITE TOI could not keep up.
