CRAFTY POWER set the pace to the second turn, responded to pressure and drew clear to mid stretch then was kept to task to the line. DANCIN CANDY had no speed, was roused entering the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, could not threaten the winner but caught BLUE TORPEDO late for the place. BLUE TORPEDO settled three wide for five furlongs, bid three wide and picked off rivals on the second turn but lost his punch in the final furlong. SPEED ROUSER tracked the pace to the second turn, shifted three wide and tried to rally to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. HONOUR THE WEST pressed the pace to the second turn then gave way. UNUSUAL TREASURE settled mid pack but had nothing to offer when asked for speed and gave out.
