Footnotes

HUNTER CREEK was rated to the backstretch, responded when asked for more speed leaving the five eighths, was put to a drive into the second turn, rallied four wide to the stretch then wore down his stablemate in the final sixteenth. OLD ED attended the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide and inched clear to mid stretch then could not stall the winner but saved second. JOHNNY THE WATCH had no speed, was roused three wide on the second turn then closed steadily through the stretch. PARKO (FR) also had no speed, was outside of JOHNNY THE WATCH and four wide to the stretch then also made progress in the final furlong. WAY TOO MUCH was allowed to settle for a half mile, saved ground on the second turn but finished evenly in the final furlong. PUTMEINYOURWILL chased the pace to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch but gave way in the drive. SCALDING PASSION was hustled and dueled from the rail for six furlongs then stopped through the stretch.
