Footnotes

HEIR TO MONEY checked in the early going then chased the pace to the second turn, rallied three then four wide to the stretch, took over a furlong out then shook loose under steady urging. STEFANELLI pressed the pace to the second turn, offered his best bid two wide to the stretch, was outrun by the winner to mid stretch but kept to task and saved the place. THE TOUR DIRECTOR eased out before reaching the first turn, was widest on the backstretch, bid four then five wide to the stretch while rallying to the stretch then was no match for the winner and missed second. PREACHER WILLIE settled mid pack to the half, bid inside on the second turn, ran into traffic and was blocked behind horses from the five sixteenth pole to the stretch then angled out widest and showed some interest once clear. CARLSBAD LAGOON lagged for a half mile, rallied three then four wide on the second turn to reach a contending position to mid stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. BENEZIT had no speed, settled for a half, bid two then three wide on the second turn, also loomed a threat in upper stretch but also could not sustain the needed bid. CARNIVAL CANDYMAN was also settled early then was asked for speed nearing the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch then could not make an impact in the drive. I C SPUTNIK tracked the pace to the second turn then saved ground while racing into contention to the stretch but weakened in the drive. EDDIE CODDANA was used early, stalked the pace four wide to the half, bid three wide on the second turn but tired after six furlongs. DRAW TWO BUCK was sent for speed, set the pace for six furlongs then gave out.
