Footnotes

DUGAN BILL took back early and raced unhurried from off the rail, commenced his bid once on the second turn and angle three wide and rally quickly into the stretch, forged to the front nearing the furlong pole and drew off without need of the whip. BIG BAD BROWN was well placed just off the leaders from the inside, moved up from the two path on the second turn, eased out for room once in the stretch and came on willingly for the place. TRIPLE ACTION set all of the pace from the inside but had little to offer once challenged by the winner. CHATNWITHASCHOONER was void of early speed, saved ground into the lane and passed tiring horses. HARD SLIDER lagged to the second turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch but lost his punch. UNEXPECTED GIFT prompted the pace two wide to the head of the lane and gave out. STEPPINGINTHELIGHT stalked three wide to the second turn then had little left. CHISENAU was never a serious factor.
