Footnotes

DARK MATTER attended the pace between rivals, was roused two wide on the second turn, dueled to the stretch, got headed by the runnerup a furlong out but fought back bravely and prevailed. WAY SPEED never far back to the second turn, was fanned four wide while rallying to the stretch, stuck a head in front in mid stretch but could not stave off the winner's rally. ONE OFTHE OTHERS was allowed to settle to the half, came two wide to the stretch then was caught in traffic and forced to wait a bit to mid stretch, had room when the winner drifted out slightly and finished willingly. RUMMYSECRET WAR had no speed, saved ground to the middle of the second turn then shifted out into the stretch and was closing ground late. BLACKJACK KETCHUM prompted the pace three wide for six furlongs then gave way. TAKIN A BREAK dueled from the rail for six furlongs then stopped.
