NOW VICTORY broke a step slow but was quickly in stride and took a clear lead once on the first turn, pulled hard while maintaining his advantage on the backstretch, responded once called upon leaving the quarter pole and finished strongly to be edging away late. MCCANN'S MOJAVE was never far back, moved up from off the rail on the second turn, offered his bid in the upper stretch but could not get by in the lane. SIREN LURE broke alertly but was permitted to settle and raced four wide to the backstretch, advanced three wide on the second turn, loomed a factor in the upper stretch but flattened out. PASS THE HEAT lagged early while three wide to the backstretch, remained three wide on the second turn to rally into the lane but finished evenly. NORM'S NEPHEW stalked the winner two wide to the second turn, saved ground into the lane and failed to rally. PUTMEINYOURWILL raced unhurried from the inside to the second turn, came off the rail but did not respond. AMAZIN BLUE raced well back to the stretch then could not muster the needed rally. BWANA BULL flashed speed from the inside but faded steadily.
