SWINGN' NOTES was forwardly placed from the outset without need of urging, advanced steadily from the inside on the second turn, waited for room inside SECRET CORSAGE leaving the quarter pole, shifted outside that rival into the lane, got to terms at the furlong then gradually edged away driving. SECRET CORSAGE raced up four wide into the first turn to take a slim advantage, extended the lead on the backstretch while racing just off the rail, responded once set down at the quarter pole, met the winner's bid at the furlong pole and duelled gamely but gradually weakened. RENAISSANCE LADY broke alertly and stalked the pace three wide throughout, tried to ease outside the two leaders at the head of the lane and brushed with CHURCH EDITOR, then raced evenly to the line while brushing that same rival again in the deep stretch. CHURCH EDITOR broke inward and checked at the start then settled and raced unhurried from the inside, gradually moved closer while moving off the rail on the backstretch, circled rivals four wide to the stretch, was carried out and brushed by RENAISSANCE LADY nearing the furlong pole, the pair separated but she was brushed again by that rival late and outnodded for the show. WINDY FLAPPER raced unhurried to the second turn then lacked the needed response. PROCHONIC saved ground to no avail. LACE KNIGHTY had only brief speed. SUMMARYZE was always outrun. Following an objection by the rider of CHURCH EDITOR against RENAISSANCE LADY, the stewards disqualified RENAISSANCE LADY from third and placed her fourth for inference through the stretch
