AFFIRMINATOR broke alertly but was permitted to settle from the rail early, eased outside into the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, continued to respond and was up in the final stages to win driving. IRISH HARMONY was never too far back from the outside, offered his bid three wide into the stretch, took command at the furlong pole but could not hold the winner late. COME BACK NATIVE tracked the pace from off the rail early, dropped inside on the second turn, rallied into the lane but lost some of his punch in the late stages. KEYNIENTOS lagged to the second turn, commenced his bid two wide into the lane and closed steadily between horses but pulled up lame and was vanned off. RICO AND SUAVE set all of the pace from off the rail to the upper stretch and slackened. MERIDIAN DIABLO raced unhurried to the second turn, advanced three wide to the stretch and closed a minor gap too late. NO NIBBLING stalked the pace three wide early, had a brief bid two wide on the second turn but had little left for the drive.
