Footnotes

YAH NEVER KNOW was settled to the half mile pole, rallied three wide to the stretch, pulled even to mid stretch then inched away under steady urging. ROAR LORD was also settled outside the winner to the second turn, saved ground to the quarter pole then was eased out in upper stretch and closed steadily to the line. IRONMANN stalked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide and dueled to mid stretch then was outfinished. MICHAEL THE MAN set the pace for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch then tired. HUMBOLDT SLEW was outsprinted early, saved ground to the stretch but failed to make an impact. HIGH N DEEP pressed the pace two wide to the stretch then gave out. TWAIN'S TITAN bolted mid way on the first turn, carrying FLEET FUGITIVE out severely, was taken in hand and settled while well back then bolted again approaching the quarter pole and was not persevered with late. FLEET FUGITIVE was impeded severely by TWAIN'S TITAN on the first turn and lost any chance. Following a steward's inquiry, TWAIN'S TITAN was disqualified and placed last for interference on the first turn.
