Footnotes

DANCING YODELER broke alertly and dueled between horses early, could not go with SHERMAN BARTLEBORT leaving the three eighths pole but remained a factor, steadied inside that rival while rallying leaving the furlong pole, recovered to gain command late and won driving. SHERMAN BARTLEBORT dueled outside a three horse spread early, drew clear on the turn, drifted inward at the furlong pole and and slackened. LETHARGIC was permitted to settle early, was bumped then steadied nearing the three eighths pole, recovered and closed a gap. MOMMY GO TOO was close up early but slipped back in the opening quarter, was forced to steady hard off MALIBU CANYON nearing the three eighths pole, drifted into LETHARGIC to bump with that rival and slip back, regain his stride near the stretch and closed willingly. MEMPHIS MOBSTER lagged early, raced in the three path on the turn and closed some ground in the stretch belatedly. MALIBU CANYON dueled inside the leaders to the turn, steadied sharply to fall back and never made it back to contention. The rider aboard MALIBU CANYON lodged an objection against the winner for interference nearing the three eighths pole. The stewards acknowledged the incident but could not assume blame and allowed the original finish to stand.
