SHARP RICHARD chased the pace to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, got to terms in mid stretch then battled gamely to prevail. FLY BLUE was allowed to settle to the half, raced three wide to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and was closing steadily late. DR WILLIAMS was mid pack to the half, had to go four deep while moving up on the second turn then also was finishing well. BENBA settled mid pack to the half, raced two then three wide to the stretch and was gaining ground belatedly. PECOS BUD set the pace to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was tiring in the late stages. BUYMEABOND had no speed, settled for a half, raced outside a rival on the second turn then failed to offer the needed response. RED MAN RUN was also chasing the pace to the half, made a good bid while four wide on the second turn to loom a threat into the stretch, stayed to mid stretch then faded. CONDIMENT lagged well back for six furlongs and was not a factor. UNUSUAL TALENT trailed to the stretch and also was never prominent. AL FAATIK drifted out into the first turn, chased the leader to the second turn then stopped.
