Footnotes

KIWI BLUES was slow to settle into his best stride but reached reasonable contention in the opening quarter, shifted outside once on the turn to circle rivals four wide to the stretch, rallied steadily to overtake ITSATOPPERSTOPPER in the late stretch and won going away driving. ITSATOPPERSTOPPER was quickly in front, took a long lead on the turn, held it to the furlong pole but shortened stride in the final furlong. WHITE MARK was void of any early speed, saved ground to the stretch and finished in a mild rally. RIVER YODLER stalked the leader from between horses to mid turn then failed to respond. PERFECT BY NATURE raced unhurried early, drifted five wide on the turn and did not rally. YODELEW tracked the pacemaker from the rail for a half mile then gave way steadily. MANTIKA was forwardly placed three wide to mid turn and weakened. GLEN OWEN chased the pacemaker from the outside to the turn then had little left while four wide.
