SEAFIRE was clear leaving the chute, turned back WARREN'S SCOOTER nearing the turn, kicked clear into the stretch then had the whip waved at him in the final furlong. ALEX AND ME showed no early speed, got fanned four wide while attempting to rally mid turn, could not menace the winner but finished best of the rest. QUITE A DUDE had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then could not threaten late. MAN LAW chased the pace to the turn, offered his best bid three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the drive. ASTERI stalked the winner early, dropped back on the turn then failed to offer a late response. WARREN'S SCOOTER pressed the pace, moved up inside the winner to briefly challenge nearing the turn, was outrun to the stretch and tired.
