PIPER'S FRIEND stalked the pace to the half, was roused three wide into the second turn and engaged for the lead into the stretch, battled to mid stretch, inched clear in deep stretch and held off the runnerup. TRIBAL SKY broke a bit slow and trailed to the second turn, bid three wide at the three eighths then circled four wide into the stretch, rallied determinedly to the line but was nipped. TRAINING ZONE JON prompted the pace to the half, moved alongside NORDIC WINTER and dueled for the lead into the stretch, responded to mid stretch but weakened in the late stages. NOT IN THIS LIFE never far back to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch, was boxed inside of the runnerup at the three sixteenths, waited briefly to mid stretch then finished evenly. TEMPESTA GATO tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch, had to check off heels in mid stretch and gave way. NORDIC WINTER set a pressured pace for five furlongs, was collared into the stretch and tired.
