SECRET SPY broke alertly and dueled three wide to the stretch, forged to the front at the furlong pole and held driving. DEEP REFLECTION broke alertly then took back and raced unhurried tot he turn, circled four wide to the stretch and finished steadily. CLASSIC CRUSADER settled early, raced in the two path on the turn and closed a mild gap inside late. MARINO'S WILD CAT was forwardly placed from the outset, slipped back from the three path on the turn but came on some late. BARTOK'S PRIDE dueled from between horses to the upper stretch and weakened. SOCKS DON'T MATCH broke slow and took a few strides to catch hold then rushed to the lead from the inside, dueled until nearing the furlong pole and slackened. RED MAN RUN showed little.
