Footnotes

BI TOMORROW was not asked for speed early, moved closer into the second turn, came four wide to the stretch, gained command past the furlong pole, drew clear and held driving. BIRD COLONEL lagged to the second turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch and finished full of run. BIG PAYDAY lagged early, moved inside on the backstretch, raced just off the rail on the second turn then finished strongly through traffic. HARLAN'S WEEKEND steadied early outside STEAMER LANE into the first turn and settled, came through inside on the second turn to loom a bold factor in the upper stretch but flattened out. T. K. FORTYSIX stalked the pace two wide to the stretch and faltered. FIND WATER was well placed early from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn then failed to respond. DANGER LURKING shared the early lead then pressed SOUTH FORTY, gained command in the upper stretch but came up empty. WILD STING showed little. SOUTH FORTY set the pace from off the rail for six furlongs and gave way. STEAMER LANE was rank early, had no speed and was eased in the stretch.
