Footnotes

CABO CHICO made the lead without need of urging and set all of the pace from off the rail, met bids near the quarter pole, responded to intermittent urging and drew clear without being asked for his best. SENIOR CITIZEN pressed the winner from the three path throughout, offered a bid at the quarter pole but proved no match in the lane. SHOWING PULPIT was permitted to settle early, moved up five wide on the turn but flattened out in the lane. BRICKYARDTRADITION stalked the winner from between horses early, dropped inside for the drive but had no response. INA BLUE MOON stalked the pace from the four path for a half mile and came up empty. OLD COLLEGE TRY raced close up from the extreme outside to the turn and gave way four wide on the turn. SAINTLY I AIN'T steadied in the opening stages but quickly recovered and raced up inside in the opening quarter to stalk the winner, steadied hard again at the three eighths pole inside BRICKYARDTRADITION and fell from contention.
