SPIRIT TO WIN was permitted to settle early, circled rivals four wide on the turn, gained a short lead nearing the furlong pole then dueled to the line and held. MINISTERFROMMIAMI pressed the pace early, took command two wide on the turn, met the winner's bid nearing the furlong pole, gave up the edge but battled gamely to the line. FREEDOM CAMP settled early, raced three wide and between horses on the turn but lacked a closing rally. PROS OR JOES hesitated at the start to be off well behind the field, showed sharp speed to reach the field from the inside into the turn, was shuffled back at the three eighths, remained a factor to the head of the lane then ducked in and gave out. MAHMOUD MEMORY sprinted clear early, led to mid turn and gave way from the rail.
