### Footnotes

VISUAL INTENSITY was unhurried for a half mile, rallied two wide on the second turn, pushed to the front to mid stretch then edged away under steady urging. LORD'S MINISTER contested the pace early then edged away on the backstretch, responded from the rail to the stretch, could not hold off the winner in mid stretch but had enough left to save the place. CODY PEAK was allowed to settle to the half, bid four then five wide while closing ground on the second turn but lost his punch in the final furlong. KINGMAN KID chased the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch but finished evenly late. HEROICALLY lagged to the second turn, was two then three wide to the stretch but failed to threaten. DUGAN BILL had no speed, got fanned out four wide while trying to rally on the second turn and weakened through the drive. DOS EQKEYS flashed early speed to the first turn, lugged out to the backstretch, stalked the leader three wide for six furlongs then gave way.
