WHO U FOOLIN contested the pace from the rail to the stretch, edged away under pressure to mid stretch then held driving. HARRY THE BOOK attended the pace outside the winner, got outkicked to mid stretch but had enough left to save the place. ONE LUCKY GUY was outsprinted to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then finished willingly inside to the line. STEELY WONDER tracked the leaders to the turn, raced two or three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. PUMP N UP had no speed early, got fanned out four wide to the stretch and was making up ground belatedly. QUIETLY WAITING broke a step slow and was outrun to the turn then saved ground to no avail. WHEREVER IT'S BEST stalked the pace to the turn, was caught out four wide to the stretch but tired through the drive. TURBULENT CREEK broke slow, had no speed and was outrun. ARTIC STORM also had no speed and was never prominent.
