Footnotes

BLUEGRASS CHAPP took a forward placing into the first turn from off the rail, moved up to pressure WHAT'S FOR DINNER once on the backstretch, got to terms outside that rival near the furlong pole, forged to the front but was all out to last. WHAT'S FOR DINNER broke on top and set all of the pace from the inside, met the winner's bid in the upper stretch, was headed but fought back gamely. JANERO was permitted to settle early from off the rail, got shuffled back in traffic into the second turn, came through inside to the stretch, shifted out for the drive and closed willingly. PROMETHEUS BULL raced unhurried early from the two path, angled three wide on the second turn to rally into the stretch but lost his punch in the final sixteenth. ALBERTA BREEZE was not asked for speed early, moved closer into the second turn two wide but lacked a closing response. BALLADEER was well positioned from the inside to the stretch but did not respond. VINDI MAN settled early four wide, offered a menacing bid three wide on the second turn then flattened out once in the stretch. OFFICER JONES showed little. ST PIRRRAN was well placed early outside horses but came up empty into the stretch.
