Footnotes

BOBBY HANDY was well placed to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, pushed to the front a furlong out and held on determinedly. LOW GEAR POWER chased the leaders to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, was outkicked by the winner to mid stretch but kept to task to the line. ISLAND BORDEAUX was allowed to settle while three wide to the second turn, responded to urging while remaining three deep to the stretch then finished in a rally late. IRON JOE T had no speed, settled to the half, bid three then four wide to the stretch and was gaining ground late. SIMPLY SHARP prompted the pace to the half, moved up to engage for the lead on the second turn, was outrun by the winner in upper stretch and finished evenly. TITIAN broke in a tangle and took up at the start then was extremely rank for the opening half mile while fighting the rider, finally settled nearing the second turn, had to circle four wide to the stretch but closed well in a good try. SUMMER SUNSHINE set all the pace to the second turn, dueled a rival into the stretch but weakened through the final furlong.
