GIFT OF APRIL stalked the pace inside, bid down the backstretch to be clear but faltered. REASONABLE CODE stalked the pace before fading in the drive. BRUSHHER and GREAT CHOICE tired from their early efforts. SALUTE TO PAULIE and SEND 'EM PAKIN were not factors. COLORFUL CAROL stumbled at the start and lost the rider.
