SHE'S GOT THE LOOT dueled, bid on the turn and was clear under a strong drive. TOOTIE'S FIRST was fractious behind the gate, stalked the pace inside, but lacked a late bid. OCALA GOLD stalked the pace four wide but lacked a late bid. RUNALONG HONEY dueled early before giving way. LADY OF THE MEADOW was bumped at the start, then improved position late. FEBES ACADEMY WON improved position late. PINK DAIQUIRI threw the rider and ran loose in the post parade. NATIVE LADY faded. STB'S HONEY was not a factor. GULCH ITS HOUR trailed, then was eased through the stretch.
