WEATHERSTORM was clear early, was challenged at the three-eighths pole, dueled, then bid at the eighth pole and drew off under a strong drive. PRINCE NICK stalked the early pace, bid at the three-eighths pole to challenge the winner, dueled, but then couldn't match strides for long. SHOOT WITH PRIDE stalked the pace but lacked a late bid. HEZA HEMI improved position late outside. MARQUETRY SKY and DOMESTIC OIL raced evenly. KYLE'S TREASURY faded. ZEPHYR CHARLIE reared at the start. GRRRIFECK faded. MY FIRST CHOICE moved back as the gate opened, then came out slowly.
