SHEZA MATCH pressed the pace for a half mile, but couldn't match strides thereafter. CIRCLE THE GLOBE improved position late. IMA BENDER BOO and ZES TEE raced evenly. PASS BYE lacked a bid. TEXTBOOK TILLIE faded. SEPTEMBERSHALFMOON was fractious loading, then showed brief speed.
