DO THE IMPOSSIBLE saved ground early, rallied on the far turn, angled out four wide at the eighth pole and was up late under a mild drive. PLEASANT ITALIAN bid inside at the quarter pole to be clear, but then couldn't hold off the closer. BUBBA BOY stalked the pace, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered. NOBLE CROWN raced evenly. CITY CODE dueled to the quarter pole before giving way. DRESSED IN BLACK was not a factor. FORMAL ETIQUETTE dueled to the quarter pole before giving way.
