NASTY SEA rallied five wide at the quarter pole and was clear late under a strong drive. MS TRAITOUR bid four wide at the quarter pole, led late but couldn't hold off the winner. CEIL'S LASS bid three wide at the quarter pole before fading. TANGLED raced evenly. TREATMENICE and KAZZIANO improved position late. SKYLIGHT DRIVE was not a factor. DEMALOOT'S PROMISE vied outside, then gave way in the drive. GREEN GLEN faded. TERRA CALIENTE was off awkwardly, pressed the pace, then gave way in the drive.
