WEATHERSTORM pressed the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole, dueled along the rail, then drew off down the stretch under a strong drive. PRINCE NICK pressed the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, dueled outside the winner, then couldn't last down the stretch. SHOOT WITH PRIDE stalked the pace, then lacked a late bid. STOVER and HEZA HEMI improved positions late. GRRRIFECK raced evenly. MARQUETRY SKY pressed the pace for a half mile before giving way. KYLE'S TREASURY was not a factor. ZEPHYR CHARLIE bid at the half-mile pole to take the lead, then couldn't last.
