FOR REGISTERED MICHIGAN BRED FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$200 to pass the entry box, \$200 additional to start, with \$50,000 guaranteed; of which 60% of all monies to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Saturday, July 16th., 2005. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The field will be limited to ten (10) starters. Should this race not be divided and the number of entries exceed the starting gate capacity, high weights on the scale will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to the weights. The second part of a same owner entry will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. (S)

REASONABLE CODE stalked the pace, bid at the quarter pole to be clear, then couldn't last. CATS COPY raced evenly. CIRCLE THE GLOBE faded. CIRCUS DU JOY was not a factor. TEXTBOOK TILLIE was clear early but couldn't last. I MATCH TOO showed brief speed.
