BURNING ELEMENT pressed the early pace, bid at the quarter pole to be clear and held on under steady urging. CREATIVE EDGE saved ground, bid late but couldn't get to the winner. AL'S BEST MAN improved position late five wide. BINN DIXIE stalked the pace but lacked a late bid. CAUGHT IN TRAFFIC was off awkwardly. NO MORE COMMITTEE vied for a half mile before giving way. HUSH TIME was off a step slowly.
