SECRET ROMEO was unrushed early, bid three wide on the clubhouse turn, took command down the backstretch, drew off, then held on under strong pressure. SMOOTH ROLLER bid at the quarter pole, wove through traffic on the far turn, rallied belatedly and was gaining late. CATCH THE DEW found his best stride late and was up for the show spot. THAT MONETARY had a mild late bid four wide. TIMELY FACTOR saved ground to no avail. THAT GIFT was clear early but couldn't last. NATIVE RUCK stalked the pace for a half mile. BLACKSTONE DREAMER was not a factor. O. B. QUIET stalked the pace for a half mile. DEPUTY STRIPE was squeezed back at the start, then stalked the pace for a half mile.
