DEB'S FAVORITE GIFT stalked the pace three wide, bid at the eighth pole, then couldn't match strides with the winner. HALF A GLANCE was squeezed back at the start, then rallied belatedly four wide. IMA BENDER BOO raced evenly. I MATCH TOO pressed the early pace, bid at the five-eighths pole, then faltered. SWEETWATER PROMISE was not a factor. CIRCUS DU JOY was off awkwardly. DEAR DONNA faded. SURE SILVER was clear early, then couldn't last.
