LITE LEGACY came over quickly toward the rail, stalked the pace, bid at the sixteenth pole to be clear and won under mild urging. Q FORTUNATE SUN was bumped sideways at the five-eighths pole, stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a needed closing bid. BORN TO TANGO rallied belatedly five wide. OBERALP raced evenly. ARMORED TRUCK came out at the five-eighths pole and bumped rivals, went clear, then yielded late. SPIRITUALITY was not a factor. FURKA PASS was bumped into a rival at the five-eighths pole. DAN LITTLE MAN was not a factor.
