TWILL DO went unhurried for three miles, inherited the lead three fences out when ACROSS THE SKY refused, was roused to task for the final two fences and won driving. PRIVATE ATTACK rated nicely in second, challenged last two fences, eased up in deep stretch when TWILL DO drifted right. BATTLE OP had an even trip and was never a threat. WESTERN FLING settled towards the rear of pack and had no final rally. ASKIM (NZ) went unhurried in last place for about three miles, moved up three fences out, then flattened out and made no further gain. VINNIE BOY (IRE) was going well in third when forced off course by a loose horse, circled back to jump the missed fence, losing substantial ground. ACROSS THE SKY had a huge lead of over on hundred lengths when the horse refused three fences out. PROFESSOR MAXWELL hit a rail at the sixteenth fence and unseated the rider. PROSPECTORS STRIKE refused to jump the tenth fence and lost rider. NATIVE MARK fell clearing the sixth fence. MUSIC TO MY EARS (IRE) hit a rail at the sixth fence and lost rider. Rider of PRIVATE ATTACK claimed foul against rider of TWILL DO for interference in stretch. Stewards disallowed the foul claim.
