ACROSS THE SKY drew off to a huge early advantage, was well rated on the front end, responded when threatened, hit the last fence and drew away under pressure. PRIVATE ATTACK chased the winner, slammed into the fourteenth fence and continued on willingly to be well clear of the rest. BON CADDO, allowed to settle, gained slightly nearing the second last, hit the last and was best of the rest. TWILL DO brushed with PATRIOT'S PATH when that one came out at the second last fence. PATRIOT'S PATH came out and brushed TWILL DO at the second last and failed to menace. PROFESSOR MAXWELL lagged back and had no impact. HADDIX failed to menace. WON WILD BIRD lagged back, stumbled after the last fence and failed to threaten. INCOMPLETE, taken to rate kindly early, made a solid run leaving the second last then fell at the last jump.
