INCOMPLETE rated along under good handling through twelve fences, steadily advanced to gain command two fences out, drew clear and was kept to steady urging. TWILL DO was unhurried early, rallied after twelve fences, couldn't match strides with the winner two fences out but finished with good energy. BATTLE OP quickly took command, increased his advantage after seven fences, struck the twelfth fence and stumbled, led through fourteen fences and gave way. J. ALFRED PRUFROCK stalked the pace, big for the lead after twelve fences and was through at the fourteenth fence. ROYAL'S QUEST trailed early and passed tired rivals. LEAR CHARM was outrun, struck the fifteenth fence and tired. VINNIE BOY (IRE) was well placed through twelve fences and tired. MAGNITUDE stalked the pace through thirteen fences and gave way. MOVE WEST was well placed early, dropped back to rate along in the middle of the pack, rallied after the twelfth fence to loom boldly four fences out and fell at the third-last fence. TRUSTED COMRAD (IRE) struck the fourth fence, stumbled and unseated his rider.
