SHIMMERING MOMENT stalked ZAPPARITION into the stretch the final time, then responded to pressure and wore that rival down to be up late. ZAPPARITION set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by SHIMMERING MOMENT in the stretch, then gave way grudgingly. SENADA reserved for more than a mile, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. TWO WONDERS stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch the final time but had no response when asked. LATE DAY SUN (IRE) stalked the pace into the stretch, then weakened. HAPPY CLAPPER reserved for six furlongs, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. COFFEE RUN rated off the pace, advanced between horses to loom a threat on the final turn, then faltered.
