MINISTER COLIN allowed to settle, saved ground while advancing around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch DEVON ROCK inside the eighth pole, then drew away. DEVON ROCK chased the pace, moved to take over racing down the backstretch and eased to the inside, responded when challenged again by AUSSI AUSTIN on the far turn, then continued on with good courage to edge that rival for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. AUSSI AUSTIN set the early pace, eased back off DEVON ROCK racing down the backstretch, came back on to engage that rival on the far turn but couldn't get by that one while being outfinished by the winner. CARLY'S REAL DEAL rated off the early pace, advanced to reach contention on

the far turn, then gave way in the drive. INDIO ROOSTER reserved off the pace, lacked a late response. ABSOLUTE POWER failed to menace. CAT 'N FIDDLE taken in hand early, raced four wide around the far turn and never threatened. DREAMING OF LES steadied on the first turn, stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. TAPAWAY was outrun. IMPETUOUS SPIRIT (GB) was not a factor. SILENT TAP tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then faltered. AMERICAN SONG pressed the early pace and faded.
