**Footnotes**

SKIBO IN JULY vied for the lead outside ANTONACCI to the top of the stretch, then drew off. SOCIO D'ORO unhurried after hesitating at the start, rallied to be up for the place. HAPPY HARVEY tracked the pace into the stretch but couldn't gain late while being outfinished for the place. CAPTAIN CRASH tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and gave way. WIRE TRANZFER outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. FAST N FURIUS CAT raced with the pace three wide to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. ANTONACCI vied for the lead along the inside to the top of the stretch, then faltered. LANDS N TRADITIONS was not a factor. ETZEME was outrun while racing four wide. YARI was done early. PEAK TOP saved ground and faded. BEGGINFORGIVENESS trailed after breaking poorly.
