WASHED ASHORE advanced three wide around the turn to reach the leader, then wore that rival down late to prevail. AFFIRMED STORM vied for the lead, gained a slim lead in the stretch but was outfinished late. BOYUM rated off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and closed to best the others. CO BURN chased the pace around the turn and tired. WHEELAWAY vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch and gave way. MT. DISCOVERY wearing a nasal strip, was no threat after breaking poorly. POINTOFREFERENCE up close early, faltered. PERSONAL JOURNEY was not a factor. FREEDOM EXPRESS failed to menace after breaking slowly. LOTS OF CASH was outrun. FIRE DOWN BELOW wearing a nasal strip, showed little. PISTOLS PROSPECT off slowly, raced in good position along the rail and faded.
