PRIME QUEEN forced early pace from outside, took charge midway on the turn then held off YOU'LL BE HAPPY in the final seventy yards. YOU'LL BE HAPPY settled in good position early, launched a rally three wide leaving the turn and closed steadily but could not get up. CHEROKEE PROMISE was reserved for a half, split horses approaching the quarter pole, and rallied mildly. ALWAYS TWINING set the pace along the inside for five furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. SOME IRISH LEGEND raced up close along the inside for six furlongs and tired. BREEZY BRI raced in the middle of the pack between horses for most of the trip and lacked a strong closing bid. FESTIVE MADAM lodged a mild rally three wide on the turn and flattened out. LA CAT failed to threaten while wide throughout. PRIVATE ALLAY was outrun while racing wide. SPLASHY WOLF never reached contention.
