SHE'S SO UNUSUAL sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail and proved best while winning with something left. RUM PUNCH chased the pace three wide around the turn but was no match for the winner. TRAVEATA angled out on the turn and was no threat to top ones. LIP SING'S AFFAIR showed early foot, saved ground around the turn and tired. DANCAWAY, four wide on the turn, lacked a rally. LITTLE SEATTLE was no factor while four wide on the turn. DEMONICA showed little.
