BATIQUE rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. MY SWEET WESTLY unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. SILVER BANDANA reserved while saving ground, came between horses in the drive and gained the show. ALL SPADES tracked the leaders into the stretch, then lacked the needed late response. ZEITING (IRE) well placed in behind the leaders, failed to rally. WANDER MOM pressed the pace outside ALYBGOOD into the stretch, continued on well to inside the eighth pole and tired. WINDSONG was always outrun. ALYBGOOD made the pace along the rail, then faltered in the drive.
