MADCAP ESCAPADE rated a pressured pace off the rail then widened through the stretch with steady coaxing. DENIM WILDCAT rated close in the four path, proved no match for the winner but was clearly best of the rest. WICKEDLY WISE gave chase toward the outside and finished evenly to show. THE K O TOUCH lunged at the start, gave chase in mid track and finished evenly. MADISON'S WISH dropped back early then finished evenly outside. STORM CITY BLUES gave chase while off the rail then empty in the stretch. SINISTER LADY chased the pace from the inside, eased slightly out on the turn and finished empty. WE'VE GOT A CHANCE was steadied briefly early. FLYING DEVIL showed no speed and no rally. ITUNA steadied briefly early. FIRST MOVE gave chase toward the inside and faded on the turn. SURREY DOWN chased the pace toward the outside and never factored.
