AWESOME ALEXANDRA rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up in time. GRAIN OF TRUTH chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then just failed to last. WITH ESSENCE reserved off the pace, made a run to reach the leaders in midstretch, then weakened. GREELEYLIKEALADY unhurried early, circled rivals three wide to loom a threat in midstretch, then hung. JOYFUL ACRES well placed racing along the rail, angled wide in the stretch and finished willingly. SANDY BAY tracked the pace along the inside, made a run to join the leaders nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. SOMETHING MORE failed to menace. INDIAN SUMMER GIRL sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. NO PUSSYCAT tracked the leaders into the far turn and faltered. PENNANT DANCER off slowly, trailed.
