### Footnotes

ZIPSO FACTO rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up in time. TIE DYE stalked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead inside the eighth pole, maintained that advantage to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. GRENOBLE set the pace along the rail, responded when headed by TIE DYE inside the eighth pole, then weakened late. LEGENDA AUREA (GER) stalked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and couldn't gain in the drive. LOVE THAT KELLY reserved off the pace while saving ground, moved up to reach contention in the stretch, then lacked room in behind GRENOBLE and couldn't do enough late. SANDS OF HUMOR moved up on the backstretch to chase the pace three wide, then gave way in the drive. STARSHIP PEGASUS chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. PRINCESS ZAIMA unhurried early, made a run four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered in the drive. MISS KIT MAMBO was not a factor.
